

50 Years Later

DISCRIMINATION STILL IN DANVILLE, VIRGINIA!

A. Fifty years later, discrimination still exists.

- **At the very location where citizens met at the cinderblock church building on Grant Street, a family owned minority company, Carnell Construction Corporation, was discriminated against by the Danville Redevelopment and Housing Authority.**
- **A representative of the Danville Redevelopment and Housing Authority wrote that he was going to “DUST” the company off. That’s exactly what happened!**
- **In February 2011, the first jury found in favor of Carnell Construction Corporation for being discriminated against by the Danville Redevelopment and Housing Authority. The presiding federal Judge wrote that there was sufficient evidence for the jury to find *racial discrimination*. He, then, overturned the verdict, ordered a new trial, removed himself from the case, and the court changed the procedure on how the case would be heard for the next two trials. Three trials have occurred and Carnell Construction Corporation never lost. One jury called it “*racial discrimination*.” Another jury called it “*breach of contract without just cause*.” No matter what you call it, the company was forced out of business by the Danville Redevelopment and Housing Authority and employees lost their jobs.**

B. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. stated, “*In the end, we will remember not the words of our enemies, but the silence of our friends.*”

- **Let us not be silent. Please support Carnell Construction Corporation.**
- **Friends of Carnell Construction Corporation have set up a website to help it while the legal battle continues in the Fourth (4th) Circuit Court of Appeals.**
- **The company looks forward to the opportunity for a jury to hear, for the first time, the complete damages caused by the actions of the Danville Redevelopment and Housing Authority.**
